### HOME IS A HOLY PLACE

The Archbishop of Birmingham, The Most Reverend Vincent Nichols, published this letter several years ago on the Feast of the Holy Family, our parish feast day. We share it with you as it is just as vital today:

There is a phrase I want to put before you. It is this: 'Home is a Holy Place.' In what sense is this phrase true?

Well, we know it is true of the Holy Family of Nazareth. Obviously, we think of Jesus Mary and Joseph as a perfect family, especially as we celebrate this Feast. We probably acknowledge that ideally this statement should be true of every home. But we may well think that saying 'home is a holy place', like so many religious expressions, is no more than wishful thinking. It is simply not true of home life today.

Yet what exactly do we mean when we say that 'home is a holy place'?

We are not saying that all must be well for home to be holy. Holiness is not about having successful children, a tidy house, or even a very solid marriage. Nor is holiness simply about having a routine of family prayer, although that helps. What do we mean?

Holiness is about having eyes for God. It is about being ready to respond to God's presence in ways that are generous and brave. Holiness is about seeing beneath the surface of daily events and having the courage to know that God is at work in them even if they don't make sense to us. Holiness is walking every minute with God. Seeking holiness is tough going.

Seeking holiness in our homes is particularly difficult. Often it's far easier to be kind to strangers than to those with whom we live, who may have just finished off the milk, taken the last packet of crisps or jumped the queue for the bathroom. It's far more difficult to accept the failures of those whom we love and to whom we have tried to give everything.

Everyone starts off with the hope of being the perfect family. But then reality sets in. All of life's difficulties begin to emerge. It's only when we realize that we are not perfect, that we are never going to be perfect, neither as individuals nor as a family, that the real work of holiness begins. When we accept that something has really gone wrong, when we have that terrible feeling in the pit of our stomach, then we can begin to discover what it is to rely on God, to have eyes for God, to walk each minute with God.

The great joys of life, especially in a family, bring us together. It is the knocks, the disappointments, the tragedies

of life that leave us stunned and shaken, the façade of our respectability seriously dented. Yet these cracks and gaping holes in the fabric of our lives are precisely the spaces through which the light and love of God enter. These are the opportunities to become holy.

This experience of fragility and failure is shared by so many. Indeed the qualification we need to come to church, to sit in these pews and join in these prayers and hymns, is that of knowing our need, our weaknesses and our failures. That is our starting point.

The family is a place where we experience this vulnerability very sharply. The family is also a place where we can experience a love that sustains and nurtures us. This is why the home is a holy place: because here we meet not only our need for God but also God's love for us. God created families so that we can participate intimately in God's creative life and love. This happens not only when new life is born into the family, but in every single act of love and kindness which sustains and protects us.

The pathway to holiness in our homes is the pathway of St. Teresa of Liseux. It is her 'Little Way', the constant effort of doing the ordinary things in an extraordinary way: as best we can. This is the way by which the home becomes a holy place. It is a pathway each of us can walk, day by day.

Your home is a holy place. Please do keep this phrase in mind. In your home God is with you. In your family life God is inviting you to know him, love him and serve him. There, in everything that happens between you, are the opportunities to please God in all that you do. You walk the path of holiness in your kindness, patience, forbearance; in your search for fairness and peace between you; in your struggle for understanding and tolerance; in your faithfulness and honesty; in your self-sacrificing love, each time you give up something you want personally for the good of the family. Everyone in a family has their part to play, as a parent or a grandparent, as a child or brother or sister. In all these ways God is drawing you to himself in holiness.

Today is a starting point. I know that through your regular presence at Mass and through your own life of prayer, God will certainly give you the gift of the Holy Spirit to strengthen you in this calling, on this pathway to holiness.

May the Lord bless us this day. May God bless our families, no matter where they may be. May God draw us closer into the mystery of life through the love we have for each other. Amen.

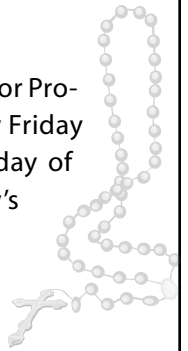
### PRAYER FOR PRIESTS

## **SCAM Warning**

It's been over 18 months since we received a message from the diocese about email-based attempts to lure parishioners into buying gift cards for fraudulent purposes. Unfortunately, this scam has appeared again in the Sacramento Diocese.

An individual established an email address resembling one used by a parish priest and falsely represented themselves as that priest in email conversations with a parishioner. In these emails, as in previous incidents, the bad actor asked the parishioner to buy gift cards to benefit others. The scammer engaged in very convincing dialogue with the victim, making that person believe the requestor was the parish priest. Again, like previous scams of this nature, the suspect may have obtained the victim's email address and name from a church bulletin or website.

Please remember that pastors or other clergy members will not typically solicit donations via emails or texts.

Any parishioner who receives a request like this should verify its authenticity personally with the purported sender before making any contribution. If a parishioner believes they have been victimized, they should report the incident to local law enforcement and to the FBI's Internet Crime Complaint Center (<https://www.ic3.gov/>).

### REFLEXIÓN SOBRE EL MENSAJE DE HOY



«Ningún criado puede servir a dos amos..., no podéis servir a Dios y al dinero». Se trata de una declaración muy fuerte e incisiva, que pone claramente de manifiesto lo que está en juego. Es preciso saber elegir con precisión entre Dios y el dinero, o sea, entre el Dios del amor y el dios del dinero. El evangelio no subraya la falta de honestidad del administrador, sino la astucia de la que hace gala en la preparación de su futuro.

El Señor nos invita a preparar nuestro futuro y a darle cuentas de su gestión con la entrega de nuestros bienes a los pobres mediante un reparto que sea justo. La riqueza no es algo maldito en sí misma, sino un servicio y un don a los hermanos que el Señor nos da, una voluntad de compartir con ellos. Ahora bien, la riqueza puede ser asimismo un riesgo permanente. Una vez que la sed de riquezas se apodera de nosotros, ya no nos suelta. Tiende a someternos y a hacerse con todo nuestro interés. De este modo, poco a poco, Dios acaba por convertirse en algo secundario o, peor aún, acaba por convertirse en un adversario peligroso que es preciso eliminar absolutamente de nuestra propia vida. Por el contrario, cuanto más se convierte Dios en nuestro único amor, en el único sol de nuestra vida, en el todo de nuestro corazón, tanto más se debilita el amor a la riqueza, hasta desaparecer por completo, como en san Francisco de Asís, para quien Dios se convirtió en el único tesoro para compartir con los hermanos. O –como él mismo decía– en su «caja de caudales celestial».

El Señor nos invita en la liturgia de hoy a practicar un discernimiento de lo que es esencial, de modo que nos desprendamos del dinero o –mejor– separemos el dinero de nosotros mismos para compartirlo como puro don de amor. En realidad, el problema principal no es apartar el dinero de nosotros, sino convertirlo en un valor para el Reino. Se trata de introducir el dinero en la corriente justa a través de la cual se abre la gracia de Dios un camino hasta nuestro corazón. Precisamente al lugar donde el amor de Dios impregna todo lo que constituye nuestra persona y donde, poco a poco, el amor lo invade todo hasta brillar como fuego incandescente de amor. Entonces tiene lugar el milagro: el dinero queda invertido en el Reino de Dios. Ya no hay «riqueza inicua». Ahora, a través del amor a los necesitados, fructificará al ciento por uno.

Ésa es la razón de que Pablo insista tanto en la necesidad de la oración: «Deseo, pues, que los hombres oren en todo lugar, levantando las manos limpias de ira y altercados» (1 Tim 2,8). La pureza del corazón, desprendido de todo y orientado a Dios, es necesaria para que nuestra oración sea luz en un mundo plagado de injusticias, en donde el dinero se convierte con frecuencia en una trampa oscura para los hermanos.

**Pregunta para los adultos:** El dinero es una parte importante en la vida moderna. Sugieran una o dos maneras en que pueden mantener un equilibrio entre la necesidad del dinero y la fe.

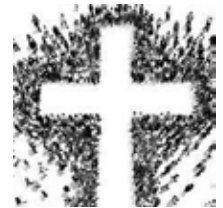

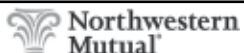
